

Adventure is Waiting! How to make your Recruitment Event More Successful

Spring Recruitment is here, which means you have an important date circled on your calendar: Sign Up Night!

HAVE A PLAN: This begins weeks in advance before the actual event. Select parents to lay the groundwork for the activity. Select a date, time and location. Contact your District Executive about learning the best presentation methods, generate 6-month calendar, and a chance to hear how the pack, den, Troop, Team or Crew

YOUR FRIENDS: When marketing your sign up night, positive, person to person affirmations of the Scouting Program drive success.

Share photo's of events on your social media, chat over coffee, or simply telling a friend about the confidence or personal growth your child has experienced in Scouting. For Troops, Crews, Posts and Ships, peer to peer interaction is the most effective.

Encourage youth to tell their friends about their memorable experiences they've had in Scouting and most important, extend an invitation to others to join the fun. Once again those snapchat and Instagram accounts come in handy as teens establish this connection and promote event details.

KEEP IT MOVING: By now, you've told others about how much fun Scouting can be. Now it's time to prove it! Don't use your sign up night as a time to discuss Scouting's worth. The experts agree that once a parent or Scout decide to attend a sign up night, they've already learned the value of Scouting. Instead, your event should be "quick, easy and fun". Give parents the minimum amount of information they need: how much, how often and when. Focus on an activity, preferably one that keeps scouts moving. No one should be sitting around.

FOLLOW UP: Make sure

to get contact information of everyone who showed interest in joining the unit. Even if a family decides not to attend, continue inviting the potential Scouts to a unit activity so they can see the fun. Most im**portantly**, Deliver all the fun you promised at that sign up night. Make sure the unit calendar includes an exciting night to welcome new members with a splash. You'll see, pretty soon, they'll be sharing Scouting with their network of friends. Then sit back and watch it grow.



Service, All Wrapped Up--5 Secrets To Successful Service Projects

A Scout is service! We have so many opportunities to show our Scouting Spirit and bring more into our family of Scouting. So when you are planning your next service project make sure you CREATE EMPATHY. When you get involved help the Scouts, understand what they are providing. For example, if you are doing a drive for coats, start in the winter and let them feel what it's like to not have coats. Remind them that

INVOLVE FAMILIES. Invite parents and siblings to participate. Give them assignments and show

that they are needed. This builds a bond between Scout and parents and the parents will step up for future assign-

KEEP IT SIMPLE. Even though parents are there and involved, make sure the service is one the Scouts could

MAKE IT SHORT. Join in on projects that only take a few hours. This will leave everyone feeling like it was a community service and fun and not a chore

HAVE FUN. You can do all sorts of things to make it fun like playing music, offering refreshments but the most fun is not having a too detailed service

project and one that keeps everyone busy and moving.


